



Parent & Player Code of Conduct:

The Team Providence Program is bigger than one person, player or individual. It is expected that parents will carry themselves in a respectful manner at all times and the following:

- We ask parents to have players at games 40 minutes before the game. If you cannot make it, please let us know the two days or the day before.
- You understand that player behavior will affect playing time and even playing on the travel team. We don't always get the calls we want but should always maintain a sportsmanlike demeanor.
- You agree to cheer on your child with pride but do not put down anyone else's child especially on our team but also the opposing team;
- You agree to maintain professional and sportsmanlike behavior at all times like your children in the many different Rhode Island cities and gyms we will be in and reinforce the same with your children;
- Encourage Team Providence players to have fun, work together. You should be cheering for all kids on our team and encourage them to have a good time. This includes other age levels of Team Providence. Be gracious with applauding for children on our Team Providence Travel Team!
- Team Providence will have at least two (2) classes for Financial Literacy and Empowerment as well as career awareness that are mandatory for players through the year to remain in good standing. There may be more offered that are optional.

Parents should also not:

- Yell at the referee in the game. Every game has good and bad calls with some more than others. Let the coach handle and represent the team. Yelling at the referee only makes things more adversarial;
- Yell at any of the players of our team or the opposing team unless they are your own son;
- Engage in Sideline coaching or walking on the sides of the court up and down to give kids direction. Let the coaches do their job and coach the kids.



Parent & Player Code of Conduct:

RIYBA Rules for Parents and Fans state the following:

Admission to tournaments, whether purchased or not, is a privilege and a revocable license and may be withdrawn at the direction of the tournament management representative(s). Your admission may be refused or revoked without refund for reasons including, but not limited to the following:

- Obvious abuse of alcohol or other intoxicants
- Fighting, taunting, or any action that may harm or endanger others in the facility
- Abusive or foul language and obscene actions
- Any behavior resulting in the disruption of the game
- Any other conduct deemed to be beyond the bound of reason for a spectator attending a youth sporting event

If any of the above rules within this code of conduct and agreements are broken, the parent may be asked to leave the premises or not attend future games. If the conduct occurs after warning, the player or guardian connected to the parent may have to suffer the consequences and miss future games or Team Providence Travel basketball entirely including but not limited to current but future seasons. There will be no refund of any monies paid for participation if the parent or player violates.
